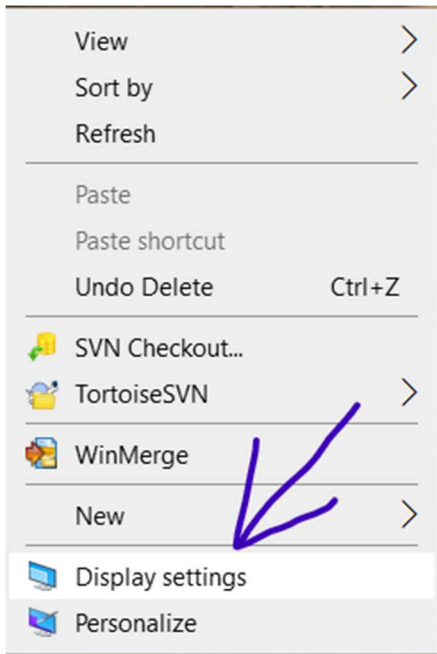


Access to the Digital WarRoom Server is through Remote Desktop Protocol built into every personal computer (and via an APP for MAC computer systems). This access depends on the local settings of the machine being used to access (local laptop or desktop computer) for the display settings.

When logged into the server and the screen resolution does not fit the available screen area a modification is needed on the local machine. Before making the modification log off the Digital WarRoom server by going to the Start Menu – Profile - Signout



On the local machine right click on the desktop and choose “Display Settings” (image is depending on the version of Windows being used in the local system)

In the Display Settings scroll down to the Scale and Layout:

If set above 125% modify the layout and log back into the Digital WarRoom server.
